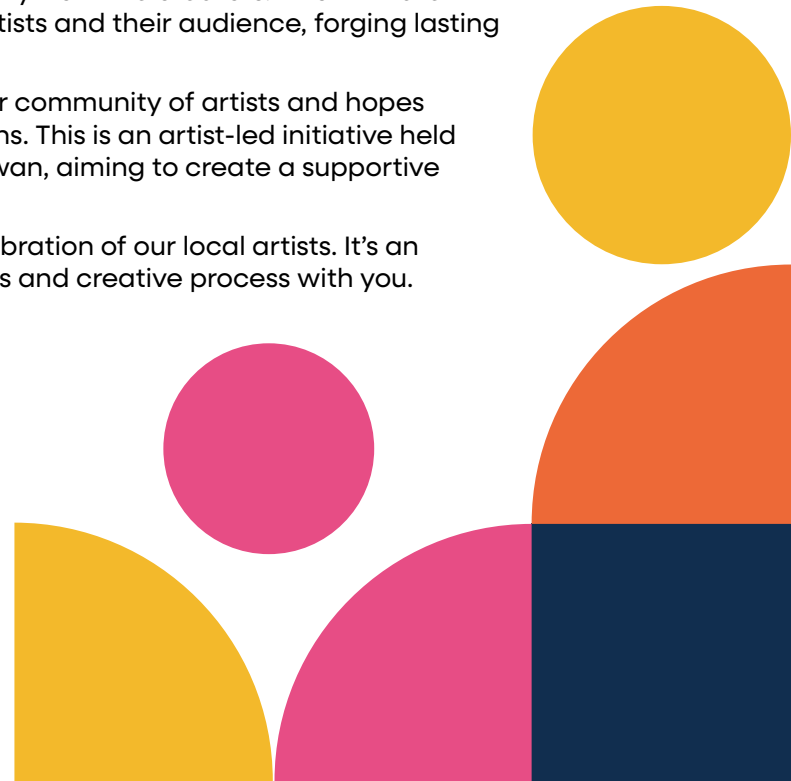
Swan Open Studios is an authentic and unfiltered celebration of our local artists. It's an opportunity for our artists to share their passion, stories and creative process with you.
